The Round Rock Parks and Recreation Department offers a summer youth track and field program for boys and girls ages 5 – 17, that will emphasize athletic development in a fun and personal environment. The goal of the program is to teach the basic principles of track and field, sportsmanship and expose participants to competition through scheduled meets. Beginners and seasoned athletes are welcome. We also encourage proper training equipment that is needed for your event(s), such as shoes, spikes, shorts, etc.

Parents: We encourage adults to get involved in anyway at anytime, such as help the coaches at practice, volunteer at meets and/or assist with fundraising for the team.

Age Divisions: The athlete’s year of birth shall determine the age division that he/she will compete in.

Registration: \$100.00 per child (resident) and \$105.00 (nonresident) & a copy of participant’s birth certificate (If financial assistance is needed please contact the Parks & Recreation Department, (512) 218-5540 x 0). Registration forms may be picked up at the main Parks and Recreation office located at 301 W. Bagdad, Suite 250, M-F, 8-5:00pm or Clay Madsen Recreation Center located at 1600 Gattis School Road. Registration will also be conducted offsite. Please call 218-5540 x 0 for a list of times and locations.

What is included in registration fee? The registration fee will provide each participant with memberships to the Texas Amateur Athletic Federation (TAAF), insurance, uniform top, uniform bottom, t-shirt, coaching, practice equipment and all practice meets, and the Regional Track and Field Meet. Some transportation will also be included to the meets. The registration fee does not cover registration or entry fees into AAU meets or travel expenses.

Practices: Practices will be held on Sunday, Mondays, Tuesdays and Thursdays at various locations (Old Settlers Park, Pool, Stony Point). Practices are scheduled to begin in May and end in August.
