

# **EWSA Challenge and Classic Player Expectations**

## **Practice & Game Player Expectations:**

- Saturday and/or Sunday games with travel up to two hours for four of an eight game season.
- All training, practices and games are mandatory.
- Teams will normally train at least 2 times per week. One of these training sessions will be with a professional trainer selected by the Team Head Coach and approved by the EWSA Board of Directors.
- Supplemental training sessions and scrimmages may be added by the Head Coach.
- If a player does not train, they will not play.
- Playing time is based on attitude, commitment, ability, and merit. Although equal playing time during match play is not a requirement, every coach is expected to allow adequate playing time for each team member to aid in his or her development without disrupting the complete nature of the team.

## **Tournaments:**

- Teams may attend 2 - 6 tournaments annually.
- Each team's Head Coach will select tournaments.

## **Required Expenses Per Season:**

- Each player must complete a Challenge/Classic registration form and pay the EWSA registration fee for their specific age division. This fee is due at the beginning of the fall and spring seasons and includes the player's uniform.
- Each player will be REQUIRED to pay a professional training fee of approximately \$100.00 per season for a trainer designated by the teams Head Coach and approved by the EWSA Board of Directors. These sessions will be held once per week during each season.
- Tournament expenses will be determined based on the number and cost of each tournament your team selects. The expenses will be handled by each Team Manager.

## **Challenge/Classic Guidelines:**

- All Challenge teams will follow and abide by the Challenge/Classic policies as established by EWSA's Challenge/Classic Director & will operate within EWSA Bylaws as established by EWSA's Board of Directors. .
- Challenge teams will have, at a minimum, a Head Coach and a Team Manager.
- EWSA's Board of Directors will appoint all Head Coaches and Assistant Coaches.
- The Head Coach will select the Team Manager. The Head or Assistant Coach may act as the Team Manager.
