Code of Conduct

The Board of Directors of Milford Little League has mandated the following Code of Conduct. All coaches and managers will read this Code of Conduct and sign in the space provided below acknowledging the he or she understands and agrees to comply with the Code of Conduct. Tear the signature sheet on the dotted line and give to the M.L.L. Safety Officer.

Milford Little League Code of Conduct:

No Board Member, Manager, Coach, Player or Spectator shall:

The use of noise devices, including *but not limited to* air horns and shakers (homemade or manufactured), is banned in *all* Cobb County Parks.

At any time, lay a hand upon, push, shove, strike, or threaten to strike an official.

Be guilty of heaping personal verbal or physical abuse upon any official for any real or imaginary belief of a wrong decision or judgment.

Be guilty of an objectionable demonstration of dissent at an officials decision by throwing of gloves, helmets, hats, bats, balls, or any other forceful unsportsmanlike-like action.

Be guilty of using unnecessarily rough tactics in the play of a game against the body of an opposing player.

Be guilty of a physical attack upon any Board Member, Official, Manager, Coach, Player or spectator.

Be guilty of use of profane, obscene or vulgar language in any manner at any time.

Appear on the field of play, stands, or anywhere on the Milford Park Complex while in an intoxicated state at any time. Intoxicated will be defined as an odor or behavior issue.

Be guilty of gambling upon any play or outcome of any game with anyone at any time.

Use tobacco while in the bleachers or on any playing field (practice or game) or in any dugout.

Be guilty of discussing publicly with spectators in a derogatory or abusive manner any play, decision or a personal opinion on any players during the game.

As a manager or coach be guilty of mingling with or fraternizing with spectators during the course of the game.

Speak disrespectfully to any manager, coach, official or representative of the league.

Be guilty of tampering or manipulation of any league rosters, schedules, draft positions or selections, official score books, rankings, financial records or procedures.

Shall challenge an umpires authority. The umpires shall have the authority and discretion during a game to penalize the offender according to the infraction up to and including removal from the game.

The Board of Directors will review all infractions of the M.L.L. Code of Conduct. Depending on the seriousness or the frequency, the board may assess additional disciplinary action up to and including expulsion from the league.

Re: All-star Selections

At the conclusion of each season, all-stars are selected in each league. The managers select and submit each team's all-stars. The Board of Directors encourages the managers to solicit input from coaches and parents in these selections. The Board feels that, by virtue of the time invested, managers have earned the right to select all-stars. The number of selections per team is based on many factors, some of which are: number of teams in a league, in park tournament seeding, number of all- star teams needed from a given league.

Fees paid during registration cover regular season play. There may be an additional charge for all-star play. Unpaid balances will preclude a player from being eligible to participate in all-stars.
