



Minutes of the MYHL Meeting of **July 11<sup>th</sup>, 2005** held at the Germantown Center at 6:30 PM.

Carl Swearingen was in attendance and covered ice issues. Collierville has turned down funding for rink at this time. The non-profit status for S&K may be rescinded. The decision will be made by the end of August. Discussion on other possibilities – Bartlett wants to wait until they open their temporary ice surface and see how the turn out is. There will be a political process with any town or city that decides to help, so this will be a time consuming procedure.

Keith Gish was in attendance and brought up his interest in bringing a Mississippi HS team into the league in a couple of years. He and Brian Haley would like to put together a Bantam rec. team with the Mississippi players. With the problems that happened last year it would be more likely that the players dispersed throughout the bantam rec. league instead of playing together. It will be discussed when we see how many register.

Options for ice were discussed and what our hockey season will look like. Tupelo will not have a minor league this year so there will not be ice available there. The River Kings has a new general manager whom Russ is working with. There will be no increase in ice fees @ DCC this year - \$225.00/hr. We are looking to get ice down by October 8<sup>th</sup>, 9<sup>th</sup> or 10<sup>th</sup>. The River Kings have more middle of the week games this year and more games which will extend their season and give us ice longer into March. There is a boat show scheduled in January so the ice will be down for 10 days. Russ has been discussing the possibility of the Jr. River Kings merging with our league.

The SAHA meeting is November 18, 19, 20 and we will be officially declaring the level of play for travel players for the season then. Most likely we will be playing at the Silver level (Round Robin format).

Tom Rose mentioned the fact that it would be nice to have business cards made up with information about the league and phone contacts. Jerry Moran motioned to get business cards made up Darrell seconded motion – approved (not to exceed \$60.00).

We are in need of HS coaches for Houston and Metro.
