MOUNT SEYMOUR LITTLE LEAGUE DIVISIONS

Mount Seymour Little League provides baseball - at all skill levels - for those from 5 through 19 years of age. Our goal is to help players enjoy playing baseball while developing individual and team skills.

Play begins in April and continues until the middle of June, with post-season tournament play in certain divisions continuing into July or August. Except for glove, shoes, and protective cup, the league provides all equipment and uniforms (pants are not supplied to Rally Caps players). Some travel is involved in Majors and higher divisions.

Please note that players must be registered in a division based on the age of the child as of **April 30, 2010**. Age categories are strictly enforced and a birth certificate is required for new registrants. Players must reside **east of Lynn Creek**.

Parent participation is essential, particularly from Rally Caps through Majors.

| RALLY CAPS | For 5 & 6 year olds, The emphasis is on learning the fundamentals of baseball in a fun, fast-moving way. We urge parents to help out with coaching and supervision...and have a great time themselves. |
| ROOKIE JUNIOR | For 7 & 8 year olds and some 6 year olds with stronger baseball skills. Uses modified baseball rules and a pitching machine. Each player hits every inning and all players play in the field. Players are introduced to team concepts and skills are further developed. |
| ROOKIE SENIOR | For 8 & 9 year olds and some 7 year olds with stronger baseball skills. Introduces the players to more standard baseball rules and a scoring system promoting defensive skills, while still using a pitching machine. Players continue to learn about team concepts and skills are further developed. |
| MINOR AA: | For 9 & 10 year olds and, if space allows, some 8 year olds with stronger baseball skills as determined by the Assessments. Introduces players to most standard Little League baseball rules and a combination of pitching machine and player pitching. This division is made up of players who are not selected for AAA or the Majors. Refer to the Assessments & Tryouts form for further details about the process. Games are umpired and individual and team skills are further developed. |
| MINOR AAA: | For 11 & 12 year olds and selected 9 & 10 year olds depending on Assessment ratings and numbers of teams at this level. Involves baseball competition under Little League baseball rules. This division is made up of players who are not selected for the Majors or indicate they do not wish to participate in Majors. Refer to the Assessments & Tryouts form for further details about the process. Games are umpired and individual and team skills are further developed. |
| MAJORS: <i>Total commitment is required</i> | For 9 to 12 year olds, involves baseball competition under Little League baseball rules. The determining factor is skill, which is evaluated during assessment and tryout sessions. The Major Division is competitive and players from this Division are eligible for the Little League post-season tournament. Any players wishing to try out for a Major Division team must qualify for and attend Majors tryouts. All 12 year olds qualify. Refer to the Assessments & Tryouts form for further details about the process. Regular Season April to June. All-Stars Season June to August. |
| JUNIOR: Tier I Tryouts | For 13 & 14 year olds, introduces players to competition under Official Baseball Rules, except for an 80 foot basepath. A strong commitment to games and practices is necessary. There are playoffs and post-season competition between leagues. |
| JUNIOR: Tier II | For 13 & 14 year olds, introduces players to competition under Official Baseball Rules, except for an 80 foot basepath. A strong commitment to games and practices is necessary. This division is made up of players not selected during tryouts for Tier I or did not attend tryouts. Playoffs at the end of the season. |
| SENIOR: | For 15 & 16 year olds, involves serious baseball competition under Official Baseball Rules, on a full 90-foot diamond. A strong commitment to games and practices is necessary. Playoffs at the end of the season. Players are eligible for selection to post season tournament teams in the Seniors division. |
| BIG LEAGUE: | Teams can include players from 16 to 19 years old. Involves serious baseball competition under Official Baseball Rules, on a full size diamond. A strong commitment to games and practices is necessary. Playoffs at the end of the season. Players in this group are eligible for selection to the post season tournament team in the Big League Division (one team formed to represent the 8 league District 5). |
