The San Carlos Patriot Senior All Star's will be recognized at the Padre Game on August 27, 2007 for their Sensational, 16 – 1 Season.

The San Carlos Patriot Senior All Star Team will be recognized in a pre-game ceremony at the Padre game on Monday, August 27, 2007 at Petco Park for a sensational All Star Season, 16 -1. This was the first time in 27 years that a District 33 Team, let alone from the Patriot League, made it to the Western Regional level for All Stars. Their accomplishments include, District 33 Champions (15 leagues in San Diego), Sectional Champions (San Diego County) and Divisional Champions (Southern California). The San Carlos Patriot Seniors beat their counterpart, Northern California, in Regional play in Salem, Oregon but lost to Arizona in the final game 2 to 0 on August 6th. Through all the tournaments, the team was a favorite of fans and officials because of their high quality of sportsmanship. They were a mere two games away from going to the Little League World Series in Bangor, Maine but they return to San Diego knowing they are the best Senior Little League Team in California!

The road to the Senior Little League World Series consists of four tournaments, the District, Sectional, Divisional, Regional then the Senior World Series. The Sectional tournament determines the best team in Southern California. The Regional Tournament determines the best team from the Western States including Hawaii & Alaska. The Little League Senior World Series is held in Bangor, Maine from August 12th – August 18th.

The Patriot Baseball League consists of Allied Gardens, San Carlos, Mission Trails, Lake Murray and Rolando Little Leagues for players 13 to 16 years of age. During the regular season the players may be drafted for any Patriot League team, for All Stars, players selected must live in the boundaries for the specific Little League.
