



Ted DeWys Memorial Referee Scholarship Description

Ted DeWys was a very active member in youth soccer within New Jersey. In particular, Ted was the head referee and referee assignor within the Piscataway Soccer Club. Ted not only was a referee but he was a mentor to many of the young referees within our club. He would work with them during the games and helped to improve their confidence and ability to work future games. Ted passed away in 2004, but we continue to honor him for his guidance, dedication, and hard work by providing a partial college scholarship to the young men and women who have also worked hard in our club as referees.

Two \$500 Scholarships will be provided by the Piscataway Soccer Club to two High School Senior recipients each year in Ted's name. Both male and female candidates are encouraged to apply for the scholarships.



Ted DeWys Memorial Referee Scholarship Requirements

The following are the requirements to receive **Ted DeWys Memorial Referee Scholarship**:

- Must have been a referee for at least one year (two seasons) for the Piscataway Soccer Club.
- Must of obtained a referee grade 8 license or greater. However, the license need not be active.
- Need not be a member of Piscataway High School.
- Need not have been a player within the Piscataway Soccer Club.
- Must be attending a Community College, Junior College, or Undergraduate College/University in the following fall.
- Must fill out application for scholarship (attached and available through our website). The following is information that will be required on the application:
 - Name
 - Street Address
 - Phone Number
 - E-mail Address
 - Year(s) that applicant was a referee within the Piscataway Soccer Club
 - A small description of your experience as a referee and what benefits did it provide you
 - University/College name that you will be attending



Ted DeWys Memorial Referee Scholarship Application Procedure

The following describes the procedure for applying for the **Ted DeWys Memorial Referee Scholarship**.

- Application is (will be) available on the Piscataway Soccer Club Web Site
- Application must be filled out (2 pages) and sent in by the deadline, which is listed on the application. Directions to whom to send the form in to will be on the application itself but can be returned to either the Travel Club Head Coach, Club Secretary, or the Club President.
- Applicants must adhere to the requirements before filling out the form.
- Applicants must fill out all sections of the application form.
- Once the form is submitted, expect to receive an acknowledgement via e-mail that your form has been received.
- Piscataway Soccer Club Selection Committee will hold a meeting after April 30th and review all applications.
- The Selection Committee will select two recipients. The Selection Committee reserves the right to only offer one or no scholarships.
- The criteria used for selecting the candidates will be based on a combination of the candidate's refereeing experience, visibility within the Piscataway Soccer Club, and the candidate's application essay.
- The recipients will be notified by phone (again see dates listed on the application).
- The recipients will be recognized on the Piscataway Soccer Club website and we would like to include a photo opportunity at the May Board Meeting, when the award will be handed out.
- Announcement of winner will also be displayed in the June Newsletter.
