Meeting called to order at 7:00pm

Old Business:

- Minutes from last meeting were approved
- Money from Ruckus debt has been collected
- Raffle money from 2005 registration will be deposited into SnoLax account as miscellaneous donation
- Wayne Burns presented treasurer's report which included:
 - a detailed report of dates/responsibilities for the club and coaches
 - detailed treasurers report of current financial statement
 - copies of each can be obtained from Wayne Burns
- Administrative Details:
 - Ethan has had to step down from the Registration committee
 - New members are to include: Doug Bratz, Ray Dalrymple, John Riley, Nathan Lawless
 - They will set dates to meet and arrange details of our new season's registration

New Business

- Fields:
- Valley View and Freshman Campus field request forms are on file with the district
 - District has not yet approved our request, but approval is not expected until later
 - Judy lawless is also to find out further information regarding field use:
 - Is Centennial Middle School a viable option for lacrosse practice
 - Does the request for field use application include the use of practice and game fields?
 - What is district's timeline for approval of our field requests
 - And again, what is our chance of using the high school soccer field, practice field, and stadium turf field
 - Phone message to Kim Thunder has been made; Kim, as of this meeting had not yet returned call
 - Email has been sent to Bill regarding setting up a meeting with him to discuss future use of Tucker Park fields. No return contact has been made.
- Judy to gather and make lists of important dates for coaches and club.
- John Riley suggested he would like to hold early conditioning for his boy's team in the months of December, January, and February.
 - Need to check with district if gyms are available for use during those months. Gym use may be difficult to secure due to basketball season
 - Brainstormed idea of using Monroe Fairgrounds
- Fund Raising

- Ike has submitted a grant to the Tulalip Indian Reservation for monies for support of field allocation for SnoLax
- Donation form to be attached to registration form and sent with mailed registration. It will also be available at the Saturday registration. We should make an effort to remind members of possible company match programs.
- Discussion was held regarding possible fund raising through local Eagle and VFW organizations
- PR
 - John Riley was asked, and he agreed, to head the PR committee for SnoLax
 - He will immediately begin working on brochures/pamphlets for SnoLax
- Equipment
 - Much of this discussion occurred during treasurers report
 - Ray presented a basic needs list and a want list (see treasurer's report for detailed lists)
 - Discussion was held regarding obtaining safer goalie equipment
 - Discussion has also held concerning lack of players interested in being goalies and that possibly we could offer to send our goalies to clinics and possibly help pay for their registration
 - Nothing was decided on at this point
- Registration
 - New committee members set date of registration for the 2006-07 season for October 28th at the Soccer Dome
 - Early registration forms to be sent to last season's players
 - Fliers to be sent to school
 - Further details and work to occur at the registration committee's work meetings
- WaLax is requiring two referees from each club; we will need to find available people to commit to this.
- Pablo from the Snohomish Soccer Dome came and presented the idea of the Soccer Dome starting a Fall/Winter indoor lacrosse league. Discussion and brainstorming occurred which included:
 - SnoLax was asked to help advertise and pass on the word of an indoor lacrosse league
 - Poster and information to be out at SnoLax registration day, but all work to be completed by the Soccer Dome
- Discussion of sponsoring and advertising for Velocity was held. Decision was that SnoLax would not sponsor Velocity, but would agree to give players information regarding Velocity including handing out fliers if we were asked
- John Riley was nominated for and agreed to become a new board member for SnoLax!!
